

# Simple List of NUISANCES

## Chapter 8.08.020

- A. All noxious Weeds that may go to seed or may create a fire hazard
- B. Dead, disease or dying trees
- C. Trees, shrubs or foliage that may destroy, impair, interfere or restrict streets, sidewalks, sewers, utilities, vehicle or pedestrian traffic or other public improvements
- D. Vines or climbing plants growing into or over any street tree, or public hydrant or pole in such a way as to obscure the view or impair access
- E. Any building which is or may become dangerous or hazardous to persons or property and building which constitutes an imminent fire hazard
- F. Accumulation of materials or objects when they endanger property, safety or constitute a fire hazard.
- G. Any attractive nuisance such as abandoned refrigerators, freezers or other large appliances or equipment; abandoned motor vehicles; structurally unsound or unsafe fence or unsecured or abandoned excavation, pit, well, cistern, storage tank or shaft; and lumber trash, debris or vegetation which may prove hazardous
- H. Unsound, putrid or unwholesome substance, bones, meat, hides, skin or any part of any dead animal or fish (or any parts of any animal)
- I. No signage on sidewalk, crosswalk, curb or curbstone or any other public place or any utility pole
- J. Any dog or other animal which howls, yelps, barks or makes other noise. Or any dog or other animal that runs at large
- K. Any sagging, leaning, fallen decayed or dilapidated fence
- L. Any storage area, junk yard or dumping ground for the storage, wrecking or disassembling or automobiles, trucks, trailers, house trailers, boats, tractors or other motor vehicles or mechanical appliances
- M. Can't put anything on our around the creeks and/or rivers
- N. NO BURNING
- O. Acting in anyway that interferes with or obstructs the park, streets, alleys, highway, streams or canals, sidewalks, etc.
- P. Graffiti on the exterior of any building, fence or other structure
- Q. Utility trailers and unmounted camper or RV in FRONT YARD of a residence (can be located in driveway or in side yard).
