REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

February 21, 2024

<u>Officials in Attendance</u>: Mayor Greg McCunn; Councilwoman Tracy Ling; Councilmen Aaron Alvarado, Ron McCoy, John Kabosky, Bruce Nupp.

<u>Officials Absent</u>: Councilman Ben Carpenter. Mayor McCunn announced that Councilman Carpenter resigned this morning from Council position #6.

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

<u>Approval of/Changes to Proposed Agenda</u>: Mayor McCunn proposed a change to the agenda by removing Mike Frizzell, Director of Public Works, from the Department Head report as he was unavailable, and adding Rich LeHew, Building Official to give a report on the Building Department. *Motion by Councilwoman Ling to Approve the Changes to the Agenda as Proposed, seconded by Councilman McCoy. Roll call vote taken with all in favor.* **Motion carried**.

Executive Session #1 to evaluate the qualifications of the Candidates for Appointment to Council Seat #7 At-Large. Pursuant to RCW 42.30.110 (1)(h)

At 6:57 pm the Mayor announced that the Council would go into Executive Session for fifteen minutes to discuss candidate qualifications. At 7:13 pm the Mayor called the meeting back to order.

Motion by Councilwoman Ling to <u>nominate Holly Ayers Hungerford</u>. Councilman Nupp <u>nominated Gaylea Nolander</u>. Councilman Kabosky <u>nominated Belle Dean</u>. Roll call vote taken for nominee Hungerford with Councilwoman Ling and Councilman Alvarado voting in favor, all other Councilmembers voting against. **Nomination failed**. Roll call vote taken for nominee Nolander with Councilmen McCoy and Nupp voting in favor, all other Councilmembers voting against. **Nomination failed**. Roll call vote taken for nominee Dean with Councilman Kabosky voting in favor, all other Councilmembers voting against. **Nomination failed**.

- Mayor McCunn stated because none of the nominees received the required minimum three votes to be appointed, the Mayor went over the options for the next step, Council may;
 - Recess to Executive Session again to continue discussing qualifications
 - Make a motion to revote on nominees
 - Make a motion to reopen nominations and add to the initial slate, once nominated, no candidate is removed from consideration unless they withdraw.
 - Make a motion to postpone the vote on nominees and solicit additional information from the applicant or nominees
 - Make any other allowable motion under Roberts Rules of Order
- Motion by Councilwoman Ling to <u>go back into Executive Session</u>, seconded by Councilman McCoy. Roll call vote taken with all in favor. **Motion passed**.

Executive Session #2 to re-evaluate the qualifications of the Candidates for Appointment to Council Seat #7 At-Large. Pursuant to RCW 42.30.110 (1)(h)

At 7:18 pm the Mayor announced that the Council would go back into Executive Session for ten minutes to re-evaluate the candidates qualifications. At 7:28 pm the Mayor called the meeting back to order.

Motion by Councilwoman Ling to revote, seconded by Councilman Kabosky. Roll call vote taken with all in favor. **Motion passed**.

Deputy Clerk Konzal read the first candidates name, Holly Ayers Hungerford, with Councilwoman Ling, Councilmen Alvarado, Kabosky, and Nupp voting in favor, Councilman McCoy voting against. <u>Nominee Hungerford was voted in</u> by four votes in favor and one vote against.

City Attorney Waters administered the Oath of Office for Council Position #7 At-Large to Holly Hungerford and <u>Councilwoman Hungerford took his council seat</u>.
