

Proposal to add the following two new ordinances to [Chapter 10.08 - PARKING AND TURNING REGULATIONS](#):

10.08.xxx Three-hour Parking Limit

There shall be a three-hour limit of parking of vehicles on the following city-owned parking areas between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. and no vehicle shall be continuously parked at said locations in excess of three hours:

- Public parking spaces along the Northern, Eastern, and Southern perimeters of the city park of the city, commonly known as Jenne Memorial Park, which is bounded on the west by Park Street (Hwy 395), on the south by Lincoln Avenue, on the east by Third Street East, and on the north by Park Lane extended generally west. This limit does not apply to the camping and recreational area, which is covered by ordinance 12.24.020, and excludes the Western perimeter of the park along Park Street (SR 395).
- Public parking spaces along the perimeter of the city-owned park commonly known as the Triangle Park, which is bounded on the west by Victoria Street, on the south by West Clay Avenue, and the north by Valley Avenue.
- Public parking spaces in the lots of Chewelah City Hall and the Chewelah Public Library that are not designated with more restrictive parking limitations.

Provided, however, a vehicle may be parked in said locations for longer time periods if the vehicle has a current vehicle parking pass issued by the city clearly displayed.

Ordinance 10.08.090 addresses penalties for violation of this ordinance.

10.08.xxx Overnight Parking Limit

There shall be no parking of vehicles on the following city-owned parking areas between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.:

- Public parking spaces along the Northern, Eastern, and Southern perimeters of the city park of the city, commonly known as Jenne Memorial Park, which is bounded on the west by Park Street, on the south by Lincoln Avenue, on the east by Third Street East, and on the north by Park Lane extended generally west. This limit does not apply to the camping and recreational area, which is covered by ordinance 12.24.020, and excludes the Western perimeter of the park along Park Street (SR 395).
- Public parking spaces along the perimeter of the city-owned park commonly known as the Triangle Park, which is bounded on the west by Victoria Street, on the south by West Clay Avenue, and the north by Valley Avenue.
- Public parking spaces in the lots of Chewelah City Hall and the Chewelah Public Library that are not designated with more restrictive parking limitations.

Provided, however, a vehicle may be parked in said locations during these hours if the vehicle has a current vehicle parking pass issued by the city clearly displayed.

Ordinance 10.08.090 addresses penalties for violation of this ordinance.

Proposed Change to [10.08.090 Violation; Penalty:](#)

From:

1. Violations of all prohibited or improper turns shall be punishable by a fine in an amount not exceeding thirty-five dollars.
2. All parking violations shall be punishable by a penalty not exceeding fifteen dollars.

To:

1. Violations of all prohibited or improper turns shall be punishable by a fine in an amount not exceeding thirty-five dollars.
2. Any person violating parking regulations shall be deemed to have committed a civil infraction, the penalty for which shall be one hundred dollars for the first offense, one hundred fifty dollars for the second offense and two hundred fifty dollars for the third or subsequent offense.

“Vehicle” includes any vehicle, trailer, truck or recreational vehicle.
