The City will NOT pick up the following in toters or dumpsters:

- Wet cell vehicle and equipment batteries
- Rock, concrete, or masonry products or materials
- Dead animals
- Vehicle or implement tires
- Hazardous materials
- Paint
- Petroleum products or liquid waste
- Propane tanks or cylinders
- Vehicle body or engine parts weighing over 25 pounds
- Medical waste

The customer must contact the City to arrange for pickup of appliances, furniture, and tires. Fees will be determined according to estimated cubic yardage.

Styrofoam pellets (peanuts) and shredded paper products must be bagged in sealed containers prior to disposal in toters or dumpsters.
