

AGREEMENT
A.101.24.42

THIS AGREEMENT made this 7th day of February 2024, by and between the **CITY OF CHEWELAH**, a Washington municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as “**CITY**”, and **RURAL RESOURCES COMMUNITY ACTION**, a nonprofit corporation, for **RURAL RESOURCES VICTIM SERVICES**, hereinafter referred to as **RRCA/RRVS**.

WHEREAS, **RRCA/RRVS** provides services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault within the City limits of the **CITY**; and

WHEREAS, **RRCA/RRVS** promotes the peace, health, morals and safety of the residents of the **CITY** by the services it provides, and said services are a benefit to the residents of the **CITY**; and

WHEREAS, **RRCA/RRVS** agrees to provide certain services to the residents of **CITY**, it is agreed as follows:

- I. **RRCA/RRVS** shall provide to the residents of the **CITY** the following services:
 - A. Trained staff/volunteers to assist Chewelah victims of domestic violence and/or sexual assault crimes, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. This may include but not be limited to services outlined in Addendum 1.
 - B. Community education and awareness to prevent domestic violence and sexual assault crimes.
 - C. Recruitment of volunteers and providing them the state mandated training to assist victims in Chewelah (these volunteers may reside elsewhere in the County).
 - D. Assistance to the Chewelah Police Department when officers identify victim needs or request assistance.
 - E. Provide the **CITY** with an annual report summarizing the services provided by the program.
- II. The **CITY** shall pay to **RRCA/RRVS** the sum of **FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS PER YEAR (\$4,500.00)**. This amount is payable each quarter in the sum of **ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$1,125.00)**.
- III. Provided, however, that should the funds be made available to **RRCA/RRVS** by the **CITY** for the services set forth above, be exhausted in the performing of such services, **RRCA/RRVS** shall be under no obligation to provide such services unless and until **RRCA/RRVS** deems that the necessary funds are available.

IV. That the term of the agreement shall be from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

ADDENDUM 1

Services to CITY Residents

1. Respond to requests for information or assistance related to domestic violence or sexual assault.
2. Provide immediate crisis intervention for victims.
3. Assist with locating temporary safe housing, food and clothing for domestic violence victims and their children.
4. Provide medical advocacy when a victim is injured and needs medical attention.
5. Provide counseling for victims and their non-offending family members.
6. Provide legal advocacy in the criminal justice system including increased awareness of the rights of crime victims as outlined in statute.
7. Provide assistance with orders in the civil justice system.
8. Provide ongoing support and assistance to victims.
9. Coordinate comprehensive services and responses across programs and systems.
10. Provide safety planning to prevent future incidents of crime.
